1. Access PPQ 287 Issuance Page

There are two ways to access the PPQ 287 Issuance Page:

- a. From the Inspection Results page after a finding with a regulatory action outcome is completed. Click on the Create 287 Tab
 Create 287 > which is located on the down right side of the page.
- b. From the main workspace, on the Inspections or Regulatory Action Panes, click on the Create

The PPQ 287 Issuance page is divided by headings similar to other pages throughout ARM. These heading have different fields. Many of these fields are dropdown lists. Some of them will already be populated if the information was previously entered in another page throughout the ARM workflow.

3. Cancel a PPQ 287

An issued PPQ 287 might have to be cancelled for different reasons. For instance, an update has to be made or the issuance was done by mistake among other reasons. ARM provides this capability.
